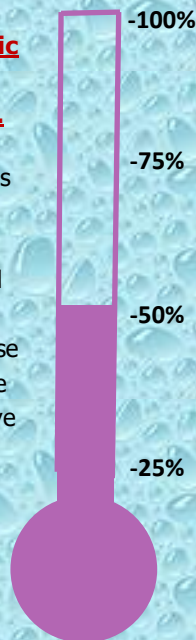

We are an experienced outdoor setting. Giving Children and Young People (CYP) a safe place to explore nature and engage in a variety of intervention to support their well-being. We have professional dedicated staff with a background in supporting CYP who are neurodiverse and neurotypical to access nature while having fun, learn new skills, engage positively with professionals and learn life skills. all at our site on Par Moor

1-2-1 NURTURE SUPPORT

This is for children and young people struggling to access/maintain education. Often neurodiverse or with social emotional and mental health issues. We use various interventions to support this CYP on a 1-2-1 basis.



GROUP SESSIONS OF EITHER 6 WEEKS 12 WEEKS OR A YEAR

Up to 15 CYP for a 2 hour sessions weekly. These can be 6, 12 or a year. They will focus on wellbeing and engaging in nature, will get to take part in outdoor skills, cooking on open fire and arts and crafts.
